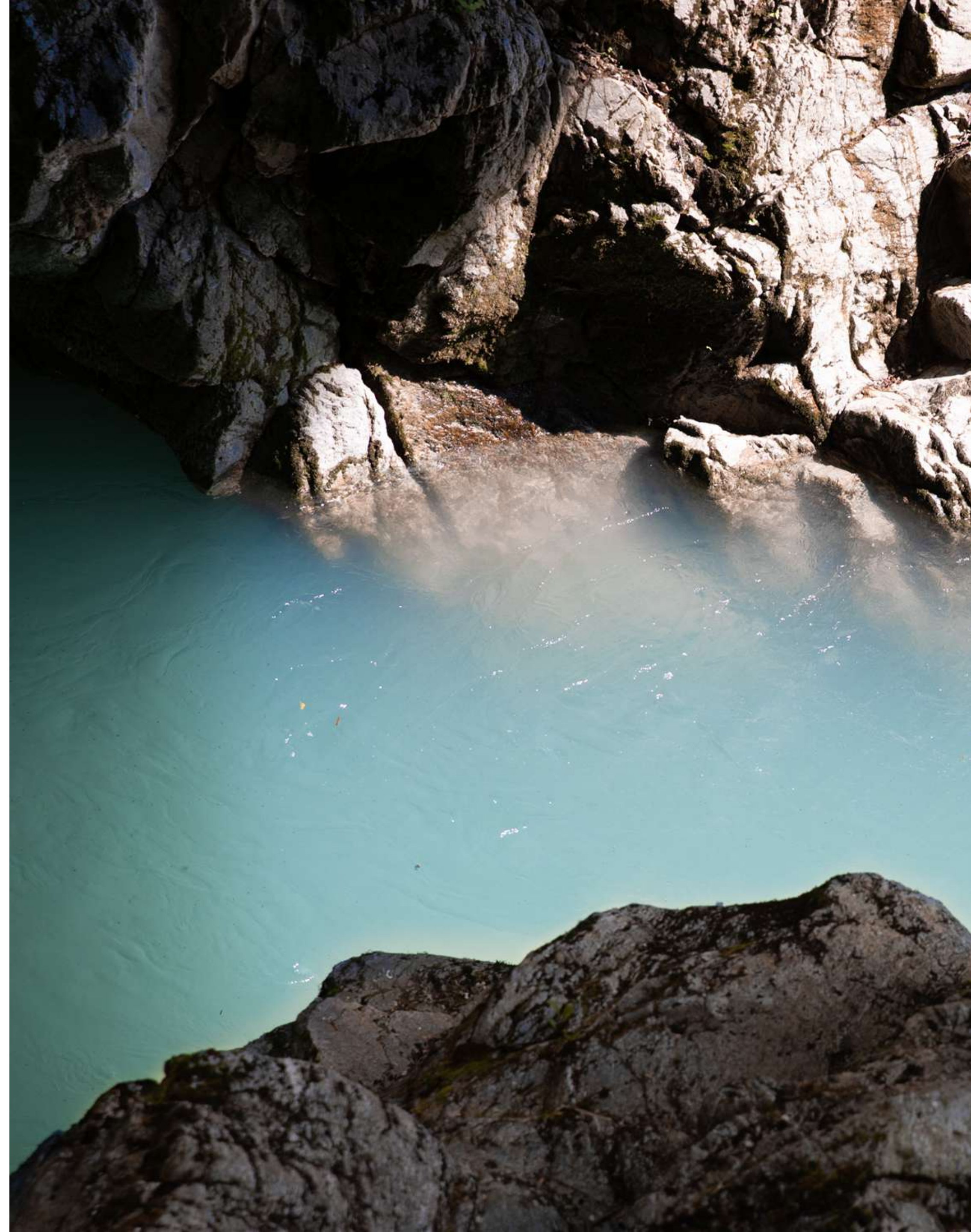
OUR PHILOSOPHY

Water is '*emozione*', it connects, it sustains life. Despite Earth being covered by 70% water, only a fraction, about 3%, is fresh, and merely a third of that is accessible for drinking. This precious resource inspires our commitment to sustainable and ethical practices, guides every aspect of our operations, from source to bottle.

Our spring is located in a protected natural park, ensuring the purity of our water and supporting local biodiversity, including a thriving colony of 3,600,000 bees. This setting reflects our dedication to environmental stewardship and the preservation of natural habitats.

Acqua di Bianchi emerges from a natural 40-year filtration through mountain strata, gaining a unique mineral profile and exceptional taste.





Our operations are powered by renewable energy, and we use advanced, eco-friendly technologies in our packaging processes. Our bottles are topped with recyclable aluminum caps, and our packaging materials are carefully chosen to minimize environmental impact, including responsibly sourced cardboard and innovative packing film that reduces material use significantly.

We employ a laser marking process for date and lot numbers to avoid ink usage, and our wooden pallets are treated with heat instead of chemicals. To maintain the pristine quality of our still water, we use a small amount of nitrogen to stabilize the bottles, ensuring it remains fresh as if just sourced.

Acqua di Bianchi embodies the purity of Italian mineral water while championing sustainability and respect for nature. We invite you to taste not just the unmatched purity of our water, but to appreciate the commitment and passion that define every bottle.

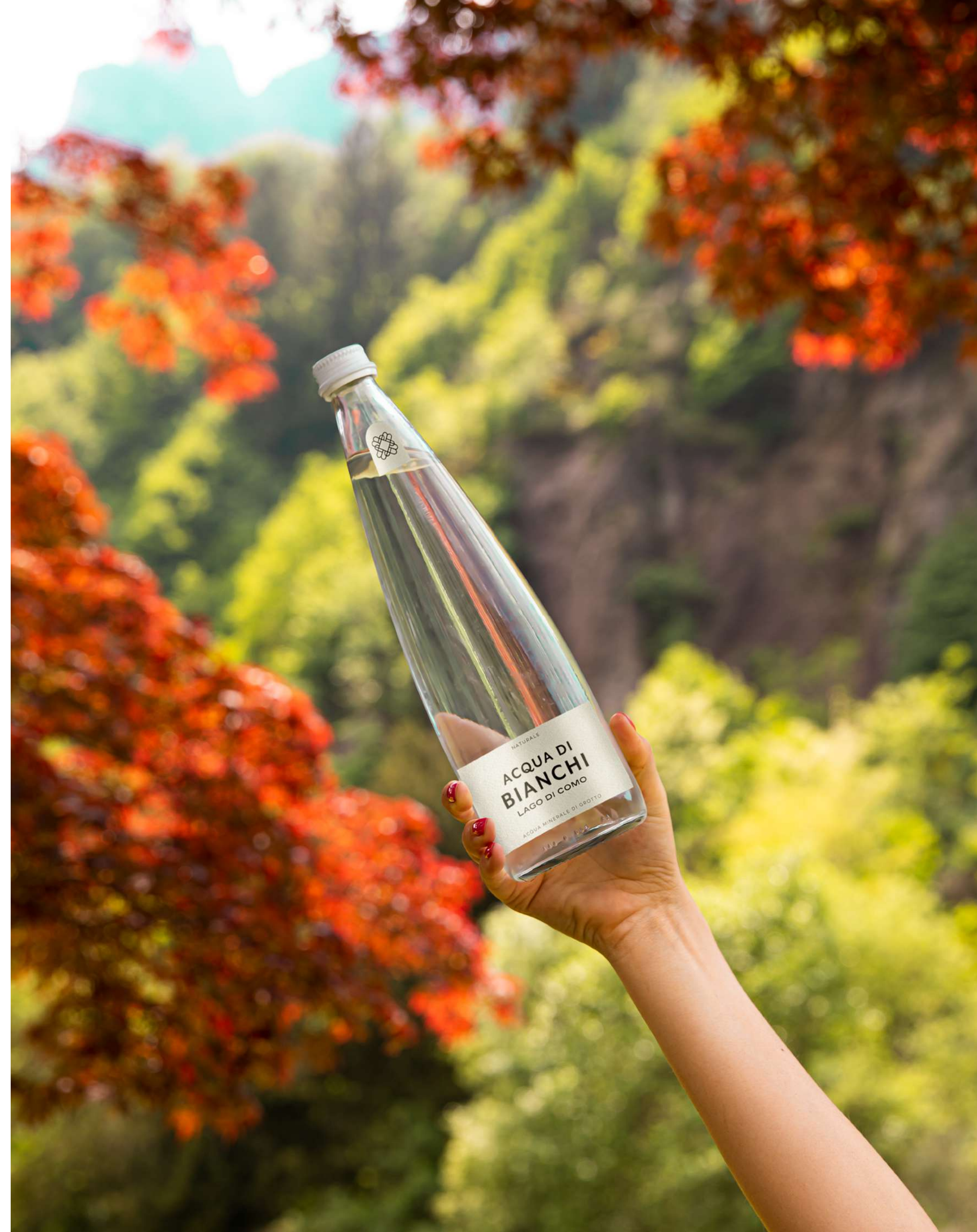
CRAFTED BY NATURE

After forty years of meticulous natural filtration through a rugged mountain chain, at an elevation of 1656 feet above sea level, Acqua di Bianchi is obtained at the Grotto of Tartavalle. This historic site is recognized as one of Italy's most ancient water concessions, where each drop tells a story of timeless purity.

This unique geological setting enriches the water with a perfect blend of minerals — sulphates, calcium, and magnesium — crafting a flavor that is impeccably balanced with a neutral pH of 7.6.

Its balance and in particular its neutrality makes Acqua di Bianchi suitable for drinking with fine gastronomy and in combination with both wines and spirits.

It is recommended to serve Acqua di Bianchi still water chilled between 50 to 53.6 degrees Fahrenheit and the sparkling variety slightly cooler, at 46.4 to 50 degrees Fahrenheit, allowing each glass to refresh and invigorate as intended by nature.







OUR BOTTLES: A SYMPHONY OF DESIGN AND FUNCTIONALITY

At Acqua di Bianchi, our commitment to elegance and purity is reflected in the design of our bottles. Crafted with a sleek, narrow profile, these bottles are not only aesthetically pleasing but are engineered for superior handling and pouring. This meticulous design ensures a smooth, controlled flow—perfect for the refined settings of high-end dining and hospitality.

The aesthetic distinction extends to our labeling: the 'naturale' (still) water features pristine white labels, while the 'frizzante' (sparkling) water boasts sophisticated black labels. This simple yet effective color coding enhances the visual appeal and assists in immediate differentiation between the two types.

Set against any backdrop, from the crisp linen of a restaurant table to the polished surfaces of a luxury hotel, Acqua di Bianchi bottles integrate seamlessly.
